

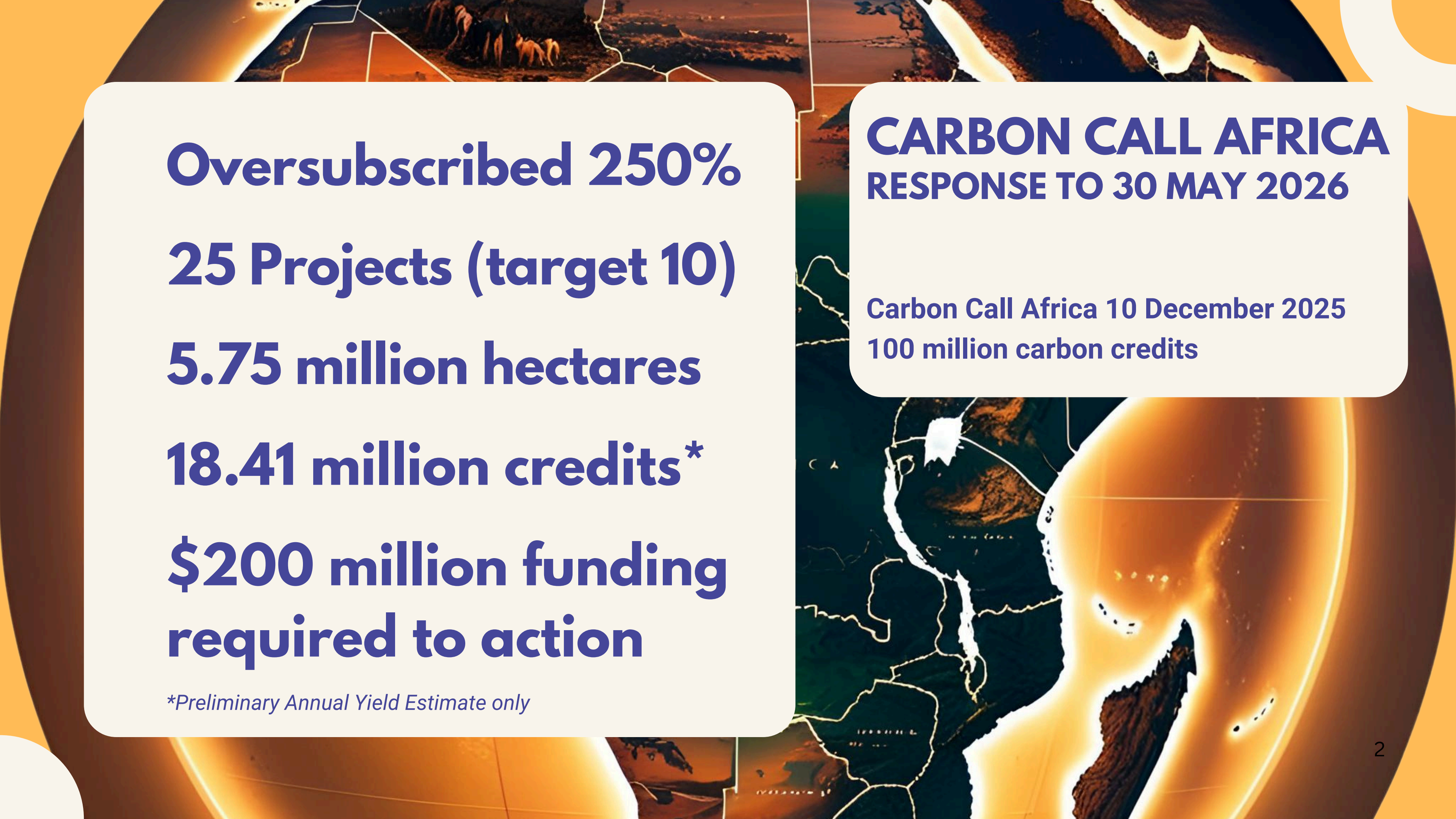

Objectives & Actions



1) Provide African Communities with a reliable system for the authentication and sale of High Integrity Carbon Credits

Introduce the [International Registry](#) of High Integrity Carbon Credits and its totally clean platform to African communities

2) Return the majority of the carbon credit revenue to the African community that owns the credit-producing resource

Secure supply contracts from legitimate owners and return majority share of revenue to them

3) Help African communities develop Community Development Plans

Compulsory Community Development Plans and audit required to ensure revenue goes to community projects

4) Co-Benefit Projects financed by carbon revenue

Facilitate co-benefit projects financed by carbon revenue

Credibility

Bad track record - mostly fake credits issued

Scaling

Large potential but scaling difficult

Expertise

Lack of science and technical knowledge

Delivery

95% of community projects need financing.
Funds often not fairly delivered to community

Overview

OUR SOLUTION Part I

1. Totally new, global high integrity RENA Scheme:

- Based on proven New Zealand Emissions Trading Scheme platform
- Standards: ISO GHG Standards and NZ VER standard for carbon credit and ITMO¹ issue, BSI 702 standard for biodiversity credit issue, target 100 year permanence
- Uses latest field and remote sensing technology (GIS mapping with AI-assisted carbon counting)
- Compulsory Community Development Plan (CDP) monitors use of funds
- Compliant with UNFCCC and ICVCM*
- Previously discredited schemes not permitted

2. On-line process, authentication, rating

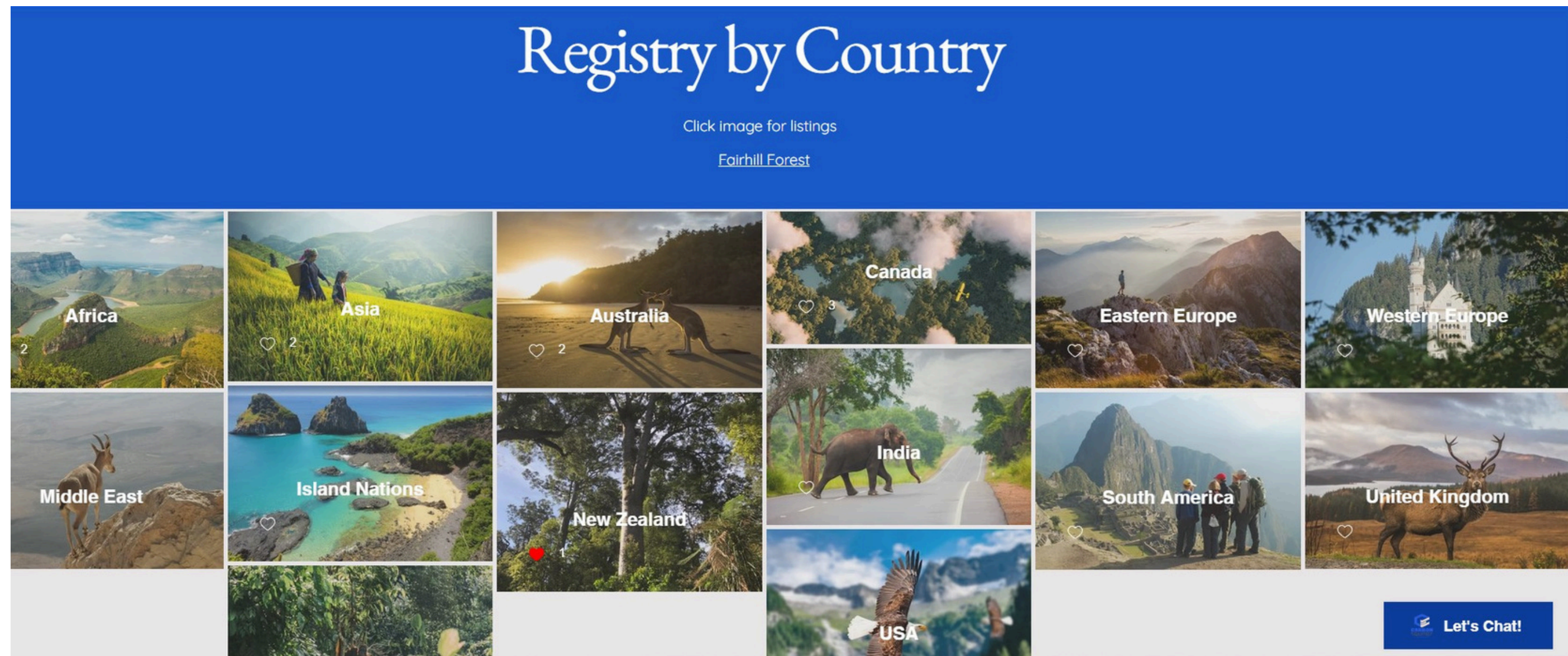
3. AHICP sources funding for needy communities

4. Credit Sales - authenticated sell Direct or by Auction; Pending (Pre-Pay Forward Contract); Shop online

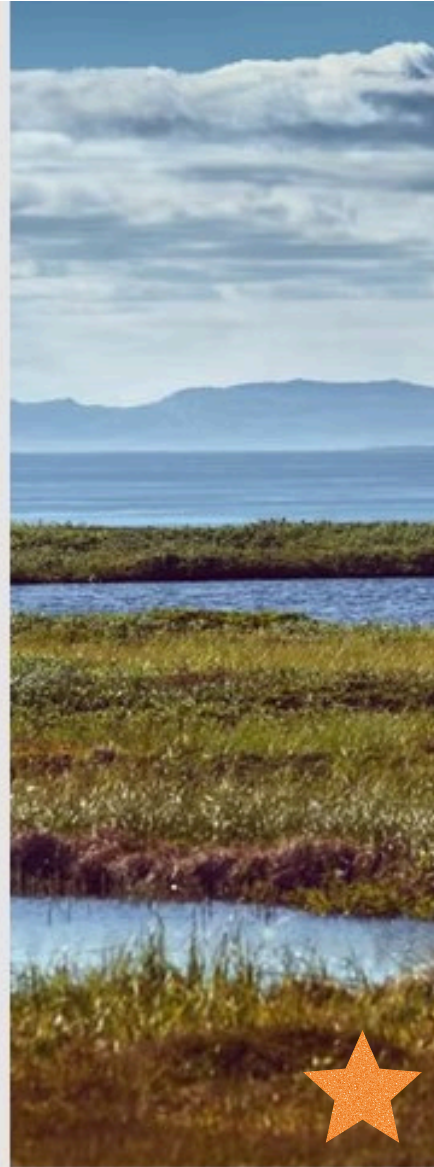

- Project Managers - Community Development

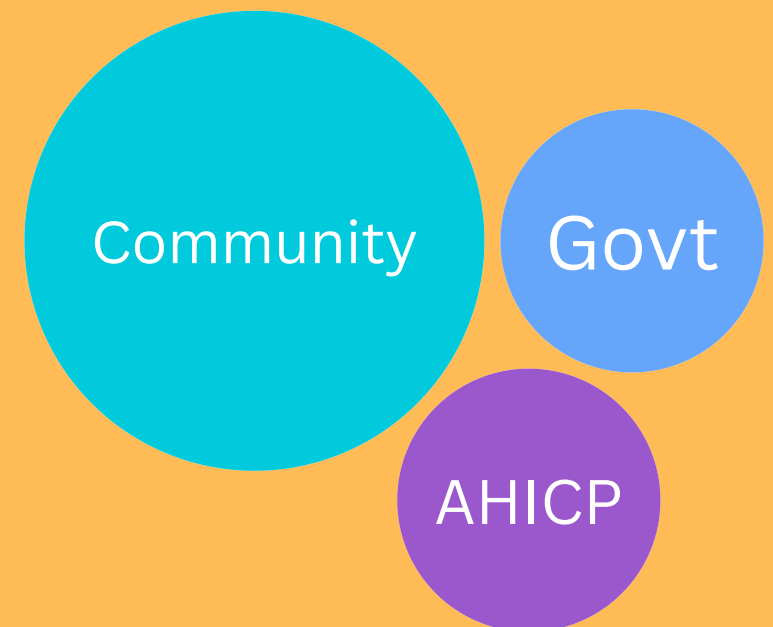

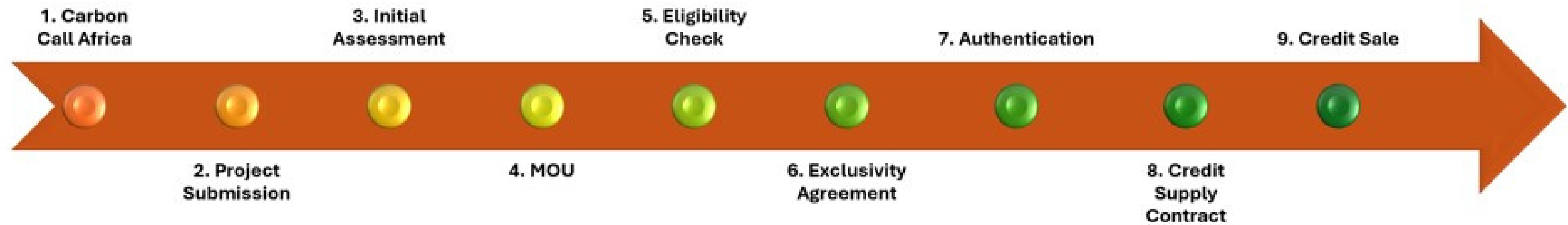

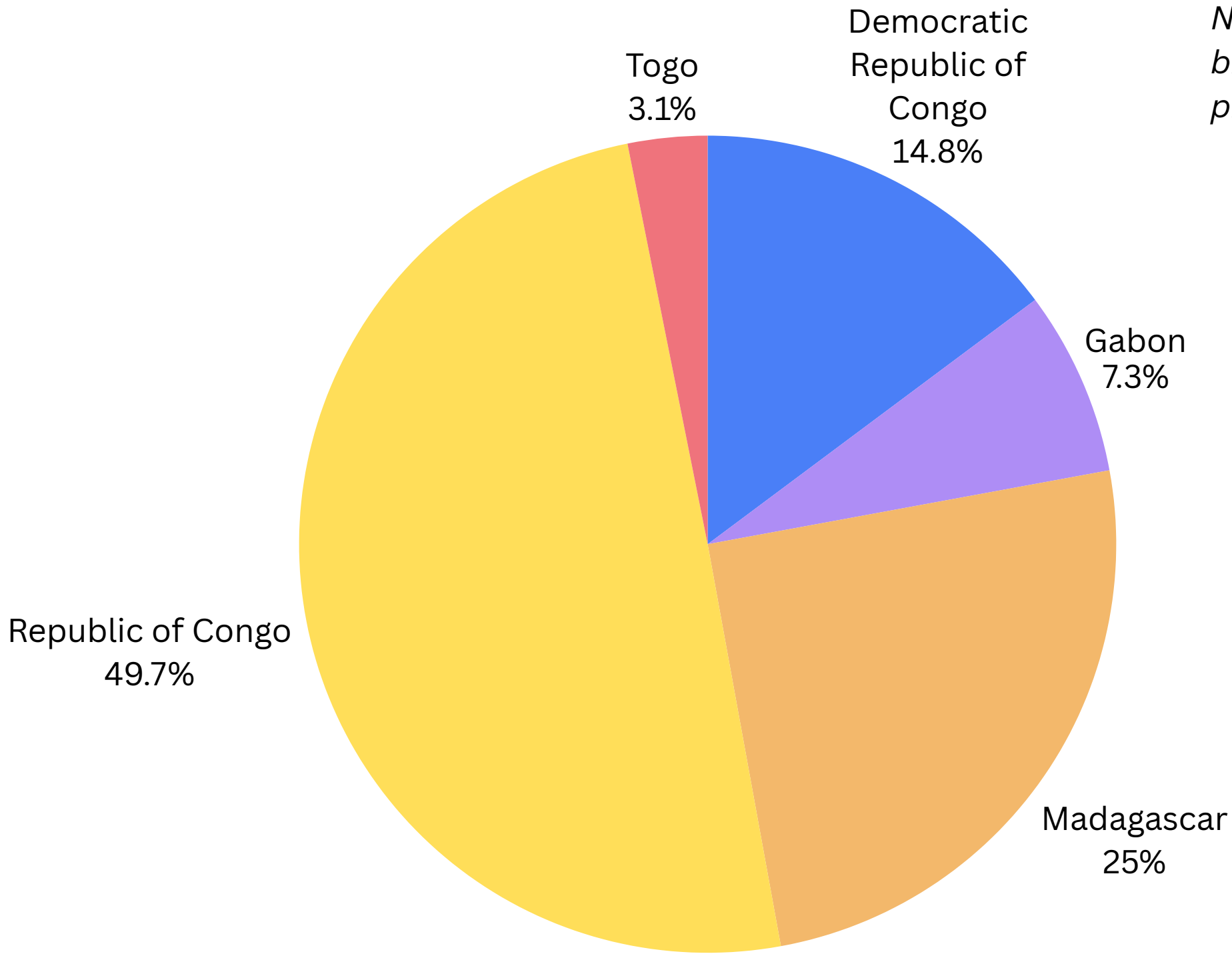
Carbon Call Africa – Dec 2025



OVERSUBSCRIBED 250%

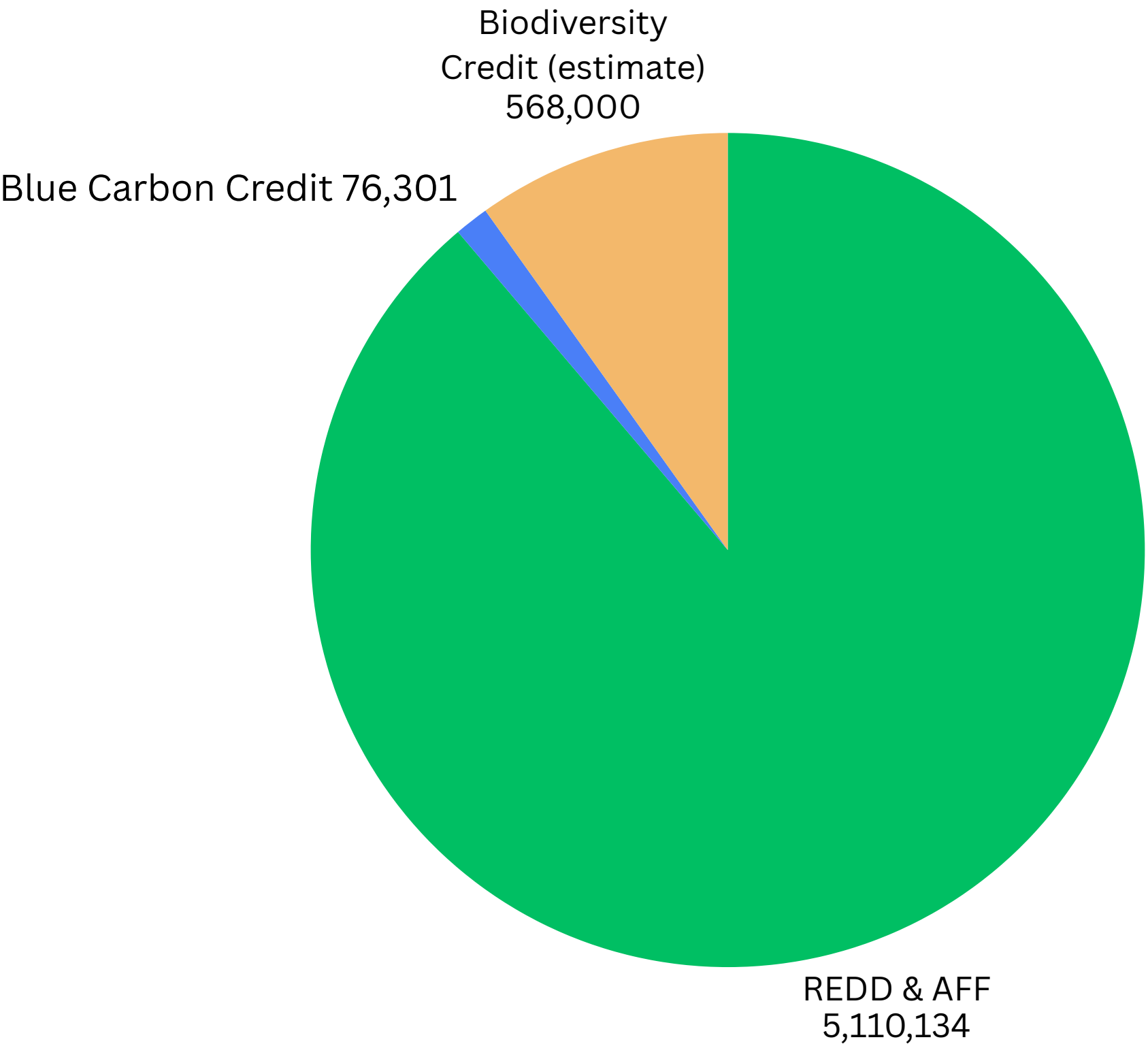
- 5 African countries

Response – Projects by Country

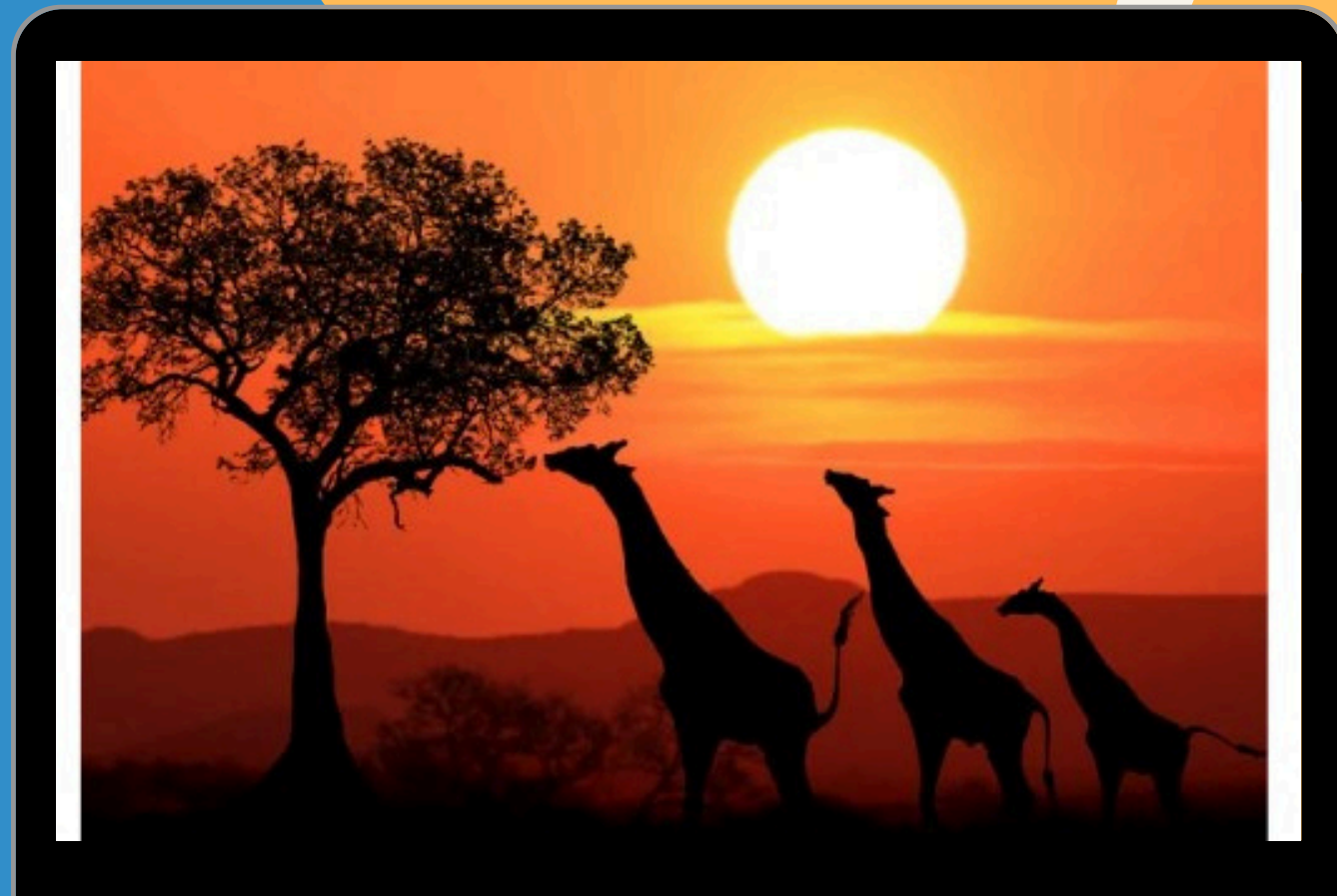


Note: Possibility of developing a biodiversity corridor with adjacent projects across the Congo

Note: Biodiversity credits asking price \$30,000 per credit (one credit equals one hectare of restored habitat). Asking price not yet field-verified. Biodiversity assessment can be done at the same time as the carbon credit plotting exercise

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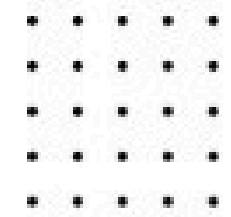
